**Payout Events: 80% divided out 3 places per event.**

- Feed Team Race, run twice, and placed by best time from either round.
- Gambler's Choice, run twice, and placed by best time from either round.

**Prize Events:**

- Double Jeopardy, run 1x and placed. Prizes to 1st through 3rd.
- Mystery sled race, run 1x and placed. Prizes to 1st through 3rd.
- Reverse Psychology, run 1x and placed. Prizes to 1st through 3rd.

**Payout and prizes awarded Saturday.**

**Bonus: Team with best time for the Feed Team Race wins a special prize (for both driver and swamper).**
