

Buster McLaury Clinics at EquiFest:

Thursday March 16th: Groundwork Before You Hit the Trail (4-6 participants) (2:30pm TPEC Arena)

- Buster will cover the foundational requirements to a solid start for trail or any mounted endeavor. Groundwork is addressed by most everyone, but sometimes there are details that get forgotten and those mistakes can carry over into the saddle. Be saddled, carry bridle, bring horse in halter with lead. Bring long lead or lunge rope.

Friday March 17th: Horsemanship 101 for the Trail Horse (4-6 participants) (2:15pm TPEC Arena)

- It's natural for horses to fear new things, some more than others. Do you have one of those? Buster will help you and your horse build confidence together using trail obstacles for the "spooky" experience. Must be able to walk, trot, & lope.

Saturday March 18th: Trailer Loading Issues (4-6 participants) (10:45am TPEC Arena)

- You made it to the trail ride, rode the whole day and now it's time to go home...but your horse won't load. Or maybe it was someone else's horse. Buster will address these issues- helping to load or loading alone. Have a horse with trailer loading issues? That's who can benefit here.
