

Patrick Sullivan Clinics at EquiFest:

Thursday March 16th: Intro to Bridle-less Riding (4-5 participants)

Patrick will take the participants through the steps for developing the trust needed for riding by body queues instead of equipment. Participants must be able to walk, trot and canter or lope confidently in an arena with several other horses. Video of riding (in tack) is requested with application.

Friday March 17th: Helping the Herd Bound Horse (3-4 participants)

Have a horse that is buddy sour or just plain herd bound? Patrick will assist you in gaining your horse's confidence to trust in YOU as the herd boss in any situation. Participants must be able to confidently lead and catch their horses. Video of your horse's response when asked to leave its buddies is requested with application.

Saturday March 18th: Advanced Liberty Work (2-3 participants)

Are you working at liberty currently and want to advance your skills? Patrick will help you to set and achieve your goals for advancing skills. Video of you and the horse you will bring working at liberty or on tricks is requested with application.
